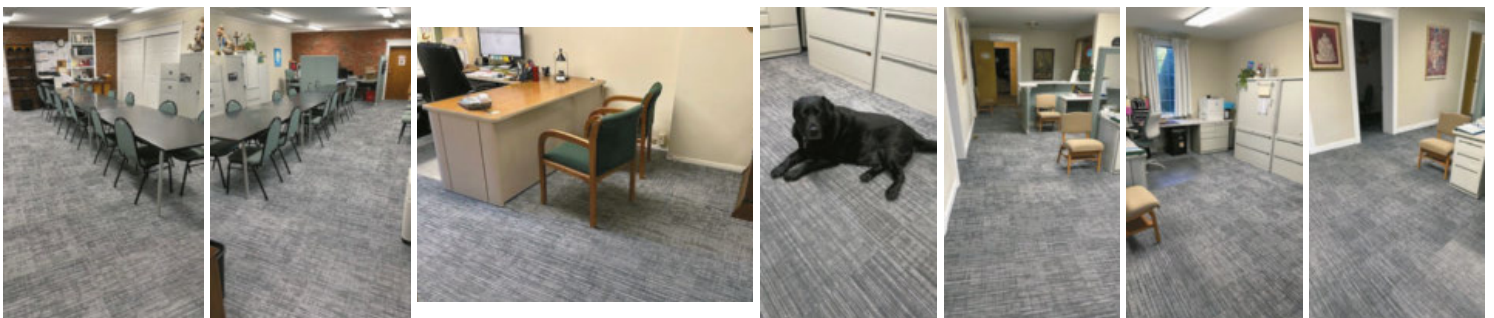

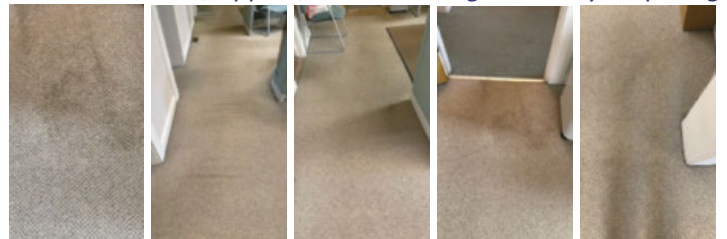

St. John Chrysostom

St. John Chrysostom, one of the most revered saints in the Catholic Church, was a powerful preacher, theologian, and Archbishop of Constantinople in the late 4th and early 5th centuries. Born around 349 AD in Antioch, he was known for his eloquence in public speaking—earning him the name "Chrysostom," which means "golden-mouthed." His homilies and writings emphasized the importance of charity, humility, and social justice, often challenging the excesses of the wealthy and powerful. He had a deep commitment to the moral and spiritual reform of both clergy and laity, and his teachings continue to influence Christian thought today.

Despite his popularity with the common people, St. John Chrysostom faced significant opposition from political and ecclesiastical authorities due to his outspoken criticism of corruption and moral laxity. He was exiled multiple times and eventually died in 407 AD while in forced relocation. His legacy lives on through his extensive writings, including commentaries on Scripture and liturgical texts, many of which are still used in both Eastern and Western Christian traditions. He is honored as a Doctor of the Church and celebrated for his unwavering dedication to truth and justice, even in the face of persecution.

*O glorious St. John Chrysostom,
golden-mouthed preacher of the Word of God,
you spoke truth with courage and love,
defending the poor and guiding the faithful.
Intercede for us, that we may speak with wisdom,
live with humility,
and serve with compassion.
Help us to follow Christ with boldness and joy,
and to remain steadfast in faith, even in trials. Amen.*

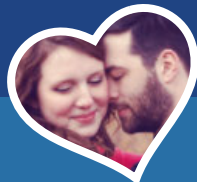
